Herzing's healthcare programs are designed to meet the expanding needs of employers in this fast-growing industry. Our programs are focused on direct patient care and healthcare administration, with study topics such as Dental Assisting and Hygiene, Healthcare Management, Health Information Management, Medical Assisting, Medical Insurance Billing and Coding, Massage Therapy, Nursing (including MSN), Occupational Therapy Assistant, Physical Therapist Assistant, Surgical Technology, and Medical Lab Technician. Most programs prepare graduates for industry-specialized certifications.

Business

In today's increasingly challenging business environment, organizations are constantly searching for well-educated individuals to fill critical roles. Our programs in Accounting, Business Management (including MBA), Entrepreneurial Studies, Human Resources, International Business, Marketing, and Paralegal/Legal Assisting, set grads up to be respected professionals in the world of business. Technology

Taught by credentialed instructors and using state-of-the-industry software and equipment, our programs help prepare graduates for careers in Computer Science, Software Development, Networking and Security, Drafting, Electronics, and Technology Management. Most programs prepare students to take industry certification exams. Founded as a technology training school, Herzing University carries a nearly 50-year tradition of helping prepare graduates for tech careers.

Design

Students studying Graphic Design at Herzing University will learn how to visually convey a message or idea to the target audience, prompting them to take the desired action. Game Development students will concentrate on the design and development of games (including animation, shading, sound, motion and physics). Industry-standard software (Adobe Creative Suite) is used and courses on peripheral skills are included. Students will create examples of their work suitable for inclusion in a professional portfolio in order to showcase their strengths and talents to potential employers.

Public Safety

Public Safety programs are designed for the protection of the public and the maintenance of a peaceful and safe society. Offering study areas in Criminal Justice or in Homeland Security and Public Safety, Herzing prepares men and women for careers in law enforcement, fire sciences, and other public safety occupations. An MBA in Public Safety Leadership is also available.

The degree of education that's right for you

At Herzing University, we know that educational goals vary from one person to another, and they can change over time. That's why we offer five levels of education.

Master's Degrees — A master's degree communicates to employers, colleagues, and clients that you hold a high level of credibility and expertise in your field. This credential is very valuable when looking to become an executive in your current industry, or when transitioning into a different sector.

Bachelor's Degrees — A bachelor's degree is a milestone credential that can significantly improve your opportunities for employment and career growth.

Associate Degrees — This degree is designed to provide students with comprehensive technical skills and a general studies education.

Diploma Programs — These specialized programs provide students with marketable skills that can help prepare them for a new career ASAP.

Continuing Education — For professionals who wish to sharpen or add to their skill sets, courses and certification programs ranging from CISCO to radiation therapy, project management to Microsoft Office, and medical imaging to LEEDS are available.

Student Services

We're committed to providing every student the services that will enrich their educational experience and enhance their ability to achieve their career goals.

Career Development — Herzing's dedicated Career Development staff assists students with employment in their field of study and works with local employers to match Herzing interns and graduates to their hiring needs.

Educational Funding — We work with students to create an individual financial plan for funding their education. This may include financial aid (for those who qualify), family contributions, employer reimbursement, and any other aid for which the student is eligible.

Herzing Scholarships — Herzing University offers an array of scholarships, awards, and grants that reward academic performance and recognize special needs.

Student Advisors — Every student is assigned a student advisor who is their source of information and guidance on University policies and procedures as well as a sounding board for any concerns.
